****Cold Weather Reminder for outdoor recess. Children should be equipped with boots, and warm clothing, including coats, hats, and mittens. Outdoor clothing is to be worn outside only. Every student is expected to go outside for recess unless weather conditions are not safe. If you are considering sending your child back to school after recovering from an illness, please make sure that you are comfortable with them being outdoors during recess. Examples of when indoor recess will be held are:

- Heat index above 100° F
- Wind Chill below 20° F
- Raining/snowing
- Thunder/lightning

While indoors, Sweat-shirts, hoodies, and sweaters that are worn in the classroom must be solid colors or have a Good Shepherd logo on them. Also remember hats and hoods are not to be worn while indoors.****
